Dear Board of Directors:

Credible research has demonstrated consistently better outcomes for students highly involved in the arts including better grades, less likelihood of dropping out, and more positive attitudes about school. These same studies show that high levels of arts participation make the greatest difference for economically disadvantaged students. Creativity and innovation are the skills needed to prepare our children for the 21st-century. As we seek to develop the leaders we need for a future we cannot predict, we cannot define a complete education without the arts, and all students in <School District> deserve this opportunity.
